SPECIAL TOWN MEETING, SEPTEMBER 10, 1985

To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of
Worcester GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Tuesday, the tenth day of September next, at seven o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M. James W. Allen, moderator presiding. 40 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Highway Superintendent, with the concurrence of the majority of the Board of Selectmen, to establish regulations governing the repair of existing driveways or installation of new driveways within the town, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent.)

It was voted to authorize the Highway Superintendent, with the concurrence of the majority of the Board of Selectmen and the majority of the Planning Board, to establish regulations governing the repair of existing driveways or installation of new driveways within the town. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be used for a testing program, reports, and recommendations for treatment work for the Quaboag Street well. Said money to be expended under the direction of the Board of Water Commissioners, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Department).

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$12,000.00 to be used for a testing program, reports, and recommendations for treatment work for the Quaboag Street well. Said money will be expended under the direction of the Board of Water Commissioners. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to establish a budget for the Board of Appeals, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Appeals)

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 3.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to accept the Equal Education Grant, Chapter 70A, S 4 & 5, and its conditions for the sum of \$10,680.00, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the School Committee)

It was voted to accept the Equal Education Opportunity Grant, Chapter 70A, Sections 4 and 5, and its conditions for the sum of \$10,680.00. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town of Brookfield, as a member town, will accept its portion of the Equal Educational Opportunity Grant, Chapter 70A, S 4 & 5, award to Tantasqua Regional School District for the sum of \$27,362.00, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the School Department)

It was voted that the Town of Brookfield, as a member town, accept its portion of the Equal Educational Opportunity Grant, Chapter 70A, Sections 4 and 5, award to Tantasqua Regional School District for the sum of \$27,362.00. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be used by the Civil Defense Department for the purchase of communications equipment. (Sponsored by the Civil Defense Director)

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$342.87 to be used by the Civil Defense Department for the purchase of communications equipment. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to allow the Fire Department to include in the forthcoming town auction certain items and that the proceeds from their sale be added to the Fire Department's Expense Account for fiscal year 1986, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Fire Department)

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to form a regional health district for the purpose of hiring a professional health officer, or sanitarian, to be appointed by a committee composed of the Boards of Health represented in said health district, pursuant to Chapter lll, Section 27A of the Mass. General Laws, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will appropriate a sum of money required to pay the Town of Brookfield's share of the costs and expenses of a regional health district, contingent upon all towns represented receiving the thirty-six month Incentive Aid Grant, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,000.00 required to pay the Town of Brookfield's share of the costs and expenses of a regional health district, contingent upon all town represented receiving the thirty-six month Incentive Aid Grant. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 7. A motion was made and voted to reconsider ARTICLE 7. It was voted to amend ARTICLE 7 into two Sections.

SECTION 1. It was voted to allow the Fire Department to include in the forthcoming town auction certain items under its jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. The proceeds from the sale of these items be added to the Fire Department's Expense Account for Fiscal Year 1986. Vote was unanimous.

Meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town Hall and Post Office in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.


