IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Thursday the twelfth day of December next, at seven o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:05 P.M., James Allen, moderator, presiding. 31 voters present.

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to establish a new account to be known as the Assessor's Clerical Account and to transfer a sum of money from the Assessor's Expenses Account for the Assessor's Clerical Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to establish a new account to be known as the Assessors' Clerical Account and to transfer the sum of \$1,045.00 from Free Cash for the Assessors' Clerical Account.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to accept a Professional Development Grant for the Brookfield Elementary School payable on February 15, 1986, August 15, 1986, February 15, 1987 and August 15, 1987, for the purpose of increasing teaching compensation under the provisions of Section 13 of Chapter 188 of the Acts of 1985, or take any action relative thereto.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$456.00, proceeds from the town auction, to the Fire Department Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$456.00, proceeds from surplus fire equipment auctioned off at the town auction, to the Fire Department Expense Account.

Meeting adjourned at 7:12 P.M.
