IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Tuesday, the 28th day of January next, at 7:00 o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles:-

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$100.00 from Free Cash to the Wiring Inspector's Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$100.00 from Free Cash to the Wiring Inspector's Expense Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be used by the Veterans' Services Department to be expended on Casework, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$8,772.00 from Free Cash to be used by the Veterans' Services Department to be expended on Casework.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement with the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the purpose of accepting Urban Development Action Grants and to establish a revolving fund to receive any such monies, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement with the Town of North Brookfield as required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the development of SoneTran, Inc. to provide for payments by the Town of North Brookfield of an amount equal to 1/2 of any increase in real estate tax revenue attributable to the UDAG-supported project into the Town of Brookfield's revolving grant fund during the term of the grant project, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement with the Town of North Brookfield as required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the development of SoneTran, Inc. to provide for payments by the Town of North Brookfield of an amount equal to 1/2 of any increase in real estate tax revenue attributable to the UDAG-supported project into the Town of Brookfield's revolving grant fund during the 5 yr. term of the grant project. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$793.59 from the Fire Station Heating System Account (Article 5, May 1985 Annual Town Meeting) to the Fire Department Expense Account for continuing renovations to the quarters area of the fire station, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$793.59 from the Fire Station Heating System Account (Article #5, May 1985 Annual Town Meeting) to the Fire Dept. Expense Account for continuing renovations to the quarters area of the fire station.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will transfer the sum of \$655.00 from Free Cash to the Fire Department Salary Account to cover salaries incurred in fighting forest fires in the spring of 1985, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$655.00 from Free Cash to the Fire Department Salary Account to cover salaries incurred in fighting forest fires in the spring of 1985. Vote was unanimous.
