IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, You are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall, in said Brookfield on Friday the ninth day of May next, at seven o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$2,000.00 from the Police Department Salary Account into the Police Department Expense Account or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from the Police Department Salary Account to the Police Department Expense Account. This ARTICLE 1 was defeated.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,346.56 paid to the town by Barletta Construction Company for damages incurred to the 8" water main at the Quaboag Street bridge construction site to the Water Department Operations and Maintenance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$1,346.56 paid to the town by Barletta Construction Company for damages incurred to the 8" water main at the Quaboag Street bridge construction site to the Water Department Operations and Maintenance Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for digging 300 feet from the town dog pound to the existing 3/4" water main inside the landfill gate, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$350.00 from Free Cash for digging 300 feet from the town dog pound to the existing 3/4" water main inside the landfill gate.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$227.75 received as reimbursement from the state for monies expended during the microburst to the Police Department Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$227.75 received as reimbursement from the state for monies expended during the microburst to the Police Department Expense Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Veterans' Services Casework Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of 53,500.00 for the Veterans' Services Casework Account from the following accounts: \$28,000 from the Overlay Reserve Account, \$10,500 from the Municipal Fuel Account, \$5,000 from the Interest on Temporary Loans Account, \$4,000 from the Regional Sanitarian Account, \$4,000 from the Group Insurance Account and \$2,000 from Free Cash.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$110.00 from the Selectmen's Expenses Account to the Printing of Town Reports Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$110.00 from the Selectmen's Expenses Account to the Printing of Town Reports Account.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,431.86 received as reimbursement from the state for monies expended during the microburst to General Highway Snow and Ice Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$1,431.86 received as reimbursement from the state for monies expended during the microburst to the General Highway Snow and Ice Expense Account.
