

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

March 3, 1987

To either of the Constables of the Town of BROOKFIELD in the County of  
WORCESTER GREETING

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Tuesday, the third day of March next, at seven o'clock in the after noon then and there to act on the following articles;-

MEETING opened at 7:00 P.M., James W. Allen, Moderator, presiding. 40 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Police Department Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Department) (\$2,000.00)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from Free Cash to the Police Department Salary Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for supplies and materials to relocate and upgrade 700 feet of water main from 6" to 12" at the Fiskdale Road Route 148 new bridge site over ConRail, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners) (\$11,289.73)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$11,289.73 from Free Cash for supplies and materials to relocate and upgrade 700 feet of water main from 6" to 12" at the Fiskdale Road Route 148 new bridge site over ConRail.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for supplies and materials to relocate 700 feet of 6" water main at the Fiskdale Road Route 148 new bridge site over ConRail, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners) (\$6,410.27)

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 3.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Expense Account for the Board of Assessors or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Assessors) \$1,700.00

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,700.00 from Free Cash to the Assessors' Expense Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$335.14 for an unpaid bill for computer services rendered by M.M.C., Inc. during fiscal year 1986, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Assessors) Required a 9/10 vote.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$335.14 from Free Cash for an unpaid bill for computer services rendered by M.M.C., Inc. during fiscal year 1986. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to hire an engineer to conduct a study of the present landfill area and to report back to the Board of Health, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health) (\$2,000.00)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from Free Cash to hire an engineer to conduct a study of the present landfill area and to report back to the Board of Health.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$800.00 from the Fire Department Salary Account to the Fire Department Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Fire Department)

A motion was made and voted to transfer the sum of \$800.00 from Free Cash to the Fire Department ~~Salary~~ Expense Account.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Planning Board Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Planning Board) (\$75.00)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$100.00 from Free Cash to the Planning Board Expense Account.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to rectify well conditions at the Pronto residence on Route 148 allegedly caused by blasting done during the road reconstruction project, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen) (\$2,500.00)

A motion was made and voted to transfer the sum of \$3,000.00 from Free Cash to be used by the Selectmen at their discretion to resolve a problem related to a well located on ~~property~~ owned by Kenneth Pronto on Route 148 resulting from the Route 148 road reconstruction project.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$5,000.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account into the Town Hall Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$5,000.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account to the Town Hall Expense Account.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to use the balance of the money appropriated in Article 27 of the Annual Town Meeting of May 9, 1986 towards the purchase of software and supplies for the computer, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

It was voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to spend the balance of the funds in the amount of 8,539.86 appropriated by Article 27 of the 1986 Annual Town Meeting which authorized the purchase of a computer to be used for the purchase of software and supplies for said computer.

Meeting adjourned at 7:55 P.M.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town Hall and Post Office in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.
