

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
May 8, 1987

To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of
Worcester GREETING

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Friday, the eighth day of May next, at seven o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M., James W. Allen, Moderator 40 Voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Medicare/Town's Share Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Contributory Insurance Account to the Medicare/Town's Share Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the elementary school budget for unanticipated special education costs, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the School Committee)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$15,000.00 from Free Cash to the Brookfield Elementary School budget for unanticipated special education costs.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Group Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$9,151.65 from Free Cash to the Group Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the construction of a float for the North Brookfield anniversary celebration, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from Free Cash for the construction of a float for the North Brookfield anniversary celebration.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Water Department Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$500.00 from Free Cash to the Water Department Expense Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be used for unpaid fiscal 1986 bills, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Accountant) Requires a 9/10 vote

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$2,167.57 from Veterans' Casework Account to be used for unpaid fiscal 1986 bills. Vote was unanimous

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Tax Collector's Expense Account to the Tax Collector's Clerk Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Tax Collector.)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$200.00 from the Tax Collector's Expense Account to the Tax Collector's Clerk Account.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Water Superintendent Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,800.00 from Free Cash to the Water Superintendent's Salary Account.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Library Expense Account to the Library Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Library Trustees)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$75.00 from the Library Expense Account to the Library Salary Account.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to rescind Chapter X, Section 12, "Rules and Regulations Governing Jeppson Beach" of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen).

It was voted to rescind Chapter X, Section 12, "Rules and Regulations Governing Jeppson Beach" of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield.
Vote was 31 In Favor 19 Opposed.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the money reimbursed to the town for damages incurred during Hurricane Gloria to the General Highway Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$6,605.00 reimbursed to the town for damages incurred during Hurricane Gloria from Free Cash to the General Highway Expense Account.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$5,000.00 from Free Cash to the Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be placed in several accounts that were inadvertently closed out in fiscal year 1986, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Accountant.)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$17,218.38 from Free Cash to be placed in the several accounts that were inadvertently closed out in fiscal year 1986 as follows: High School Marker \$200.00, Elementary Heating System, 488.43, Route 148 Construction \$3,807.20, Highway Machinery \$1,291.69, Cemetery Expense \$2,629.11, Cemetery Improvements \$2,159.08, Memorial Day \$930.67, Fire Alarm System \$1,449.95, Elementary Addition \$4,262.25.

ARTICLE 14. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Board of Health Expense Account to the Sewer Inspector's Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,700.00 from Free Cash to the Sewer Inspector's Salary Account.
Meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M.
