

Dear Attorney General,

I hereby certify that the following By-Laws were voted at the Annual Town Meeting held May 8, 1987:

ARTICLE 16. It was voted to amend Section 6 of Chapter VI of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield to increase the bid limit from \$2,000.00 to \$4,000.00. Majority Vote

ARTICLE 47. It was voted to amend Chapter X of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield by adding the following to be known as Section 15: "No person shall operate any boat or vehicle in such a manner as to create a wake during periods of high water on Lakes Quaboag and Quacumquasit and associated flood plains. High water is defined as water that is at or above 60 feet above sea level." Majority vote.

The by-law should be amended to provide that any proceeds remaining from the cash bond after the Town has intervened to complete the work properly shall be returned to the applicant. The bond provision is construed as being separate and distinct from a penalty.

Dear Attorney General,

I hereby certify that the following General By-Law was voted at the Special Town Meeting held September 22, 1987.

ARTICLE 8. It was voted to amend Chapter 10, section 16 of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield to read: "Any person desiring to construct a driveway or access way onto a public way shall make written application to the Highway Superintendent. The Highway Superintendent shall take action within two (2) weeks, setting forth conditions which he deems reasonable. No building permit will be issued until the applicant posts a certified check for \$500.00 with the Building Inspector (bond for curbcut/driveway). This amount will be deposited into an escrow account by the Town Treasurer and then returned to the applicant once the necessary curbcut/driveway is completed. If the work is not satisfactorily completed, the Brookfield Highway Department will complete the work and the \$500.00 will be forfeited by the applicant".
