

Special Town Meeting
June 28, 1988 7:00 P.M.

Article 1. To See if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the North Brookfield Float Account (Article #4 of May 1987 Special Town Meeting) to the Town Hall Expencc Account, or take any action realative thereto.

The Town voted to transfer the sum of \$480.74 from the North Brokfield Float Account to the Town Hall Expencc Account.

Article 2. To see if the Town willvote to transfer a sum of money from Cemetery Salary Account to the Cemetery Expencc Account, or take any action relative therto.

The voted to transfer the sum of \$1000.00 from the Cemetery Salary Account to the Cemetery Expencc Account.

Article 3. To see if the Town will Vote to transfer a sum of money from plowing Private Roads Account to the Highway Expencc Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted to transfer the sum \$1000.00 from Plowing Private Roads Account to the Highway Expencc Account.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted to transfer the sum of \$6020.00 to the Insurance Account, that sum to come from the following accounts: \$2000.00 from the Police Salary Account and 44020.00 from the Veterans Casework Account.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Wiring Inspector's Expencc account, or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted to transfer the sum of \$50.00 from the Print Town Reports Accounts to the Wiring Inspectors Expencc Account.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Landfill Account, or take any action ralative thereto .

The Town voted to transfer the sum of \$3259.00 to the Landfill Account that sum to come from the following accounts: \$2259.00 from Article #10 of the May 6, 1988 Special Town Meeting (Landfill Account) and \$1000.00 from the Cox Engineering Account.

Article 7. To see if the Town will to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the purpose of paying a prior years bill, or take any action relative thereto.

The voted to transfer the sum of \$231,34 from the Assistant Building Inspector's Salary Account for the purpose of paying a prior years bill for the elementary school.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Emergency Squad Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted to transfer the sum of \$1100.00, from the Interest/Temporary loans Account.

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Assessors' Salary Account to the Assessors' Expencc Account, or take any action reelative thereto.

The Town voted to transfer the sum of \$2200.00 from Assessorss' Salary Account to the Assessors' Expencc Account.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
