

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
FEBRUARY 28, 1989 7:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Building Inspector's Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from Free Cash to the Building Inspector's Salary Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to pay Eugene Toto for services rendered at the town's landfill, or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted to defeat Article 2. For 26 Against 19.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a temporary agreement relative to the use of South Pond Beach, or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a temporary agreement relative to the use of South Pond Beach.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to improve drainage on Rice Corner Road, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,500.00 from Free Cash to improve drainage on Rice Corner Road.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Agent to Defend Suits Account to pay for legal expenses and costs related to the Geoffroy case, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of 2,300.00 from Free Cash to the Agent to Defend Suits Account to pay for legal expenses and costs related to the Geoffroy case.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to purchase an oxygen unit and radio for the 1988 cruiser, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,817.75 from Free Cash to purchase an oxygen unit and radio for the 1988 cruiser.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,400.00 from the Highway expense account to the Sander Account.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,400.00 from the Highway Expense account to the Sander Account.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from Free Cash to the Reserve Fund, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,500.00 from Free cash to the Reserve Fund.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to petition the legislature for passage of a special act authorizing the Board of Selectmen to issue a package goods license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages or to grant one license, which is in excess of the quota established for the town of Brookfield for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to Connie Tomanini d/b/a The Northern Pike, under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 138, section 12, et.al., to be exercised solely by Connie Tomanini, providing that such license shall not be transferable, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to petition the legislature for passage of a special act authorizing the Board of Selectmen to issue a package goods license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages or to grant one license, which is in excess of the quota established for the town of Brookfield for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to Connie Tomanini d/b/a The Northern Pike, under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 138, section 12, et.al., to be exercised solely by Connie Tomanini, providing that such license shall not be transferable.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$1,300.00 from the Cemetery Improvement Fund to the Cemetery Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,300.00 from the Cemetery Improvement Fund to the Cemetery Salary Account.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Town Clerk's Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$214.50 from Free Cash to the Town Clerk's Expense Account.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate transfer or Borrow a sum of money to reimburse the Planning Board Expense Account, or take any action thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$184.16 from Free Cash to reimburse the Planning Board Expense Account.

ARTICLE 13. To see if the Town will vote authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement with the towns of East Brookfield, New Braintree, North Brookfield and West Brookfield to jointly establish a central communications center providing emergency answering and dispatch services in addition to other communications services, in accordance with Mass. General Laws Chapter 40, section 4A, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement with the towns of East Brookfield, New Braintree North Brookfield and West Brookfield to jointly establish a central communications center providing emergency answering and dispatch services in addition to other communications services, in accordance with Mass. General Laws Chapter 40, section 4A.

ARTICLE 14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the purchase of dispatch equipment for use in the central communications center, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to pass over ARTICLE 14.

ARTICLE 15. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to pay for the town's share of the costs of operating the central communications center for the remainder of fiscal year 1989, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$3,500.00 from Free Cash from the town's share of Dispatch Center Account to a new account to be named the Dispatch Operating Account to cover costs for the remainder of fiscal year 1989.

ARTICLE 16. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from Free Cash to the Stabilization Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted to transfer a sum of \$15,000.00 from Free Cash to the Stabilization Account.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
