

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 11, 1990 7:30 P.M.**

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Library Expense Account to the Library Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Library Trustees).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$650.00 from the Library Expense Account to the Library Salary Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to amend Section 2 of the town's Personnel By-Law by adding the following: "Any employee employed by the town prior to the implementation of this by-law in any position not so listed is considered to be grandfathered. The Personnel Board will recommend the appropriate wage range for grandfathered positions. In order for any grandfathered employee to move into a defined position, said position must be filled according to Section 5 of this by-law.", or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Personnel Board).

The town voted unanimously to amend Section 2 of the town's Personnel By-Law by adding the following: "Any employee employed by the town prior to the implementation of this by-law in any position not so listed is considered to be grandfathered. The Personnel Board will recommend the appropriate wage range for grandfathered positions. In order for any grandfathered employee to move into a defined position, said position must be filled according to Section 5 of this by-law."

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Group Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$10,000.00 from the General Insurance Account and the sum of \$2,500.00 from the Veterans Casework Account to the Group Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Assessors' Clerk Salary Account to the Assessors' Expense Account for the purpose of purchasing updated property location maps, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Assessors).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Assessors' Clerk Salary Account to the Assessors' Expense Account for the purpose of purchasing updated property location maps.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Sidewalk Account to the Highway Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$225.00 from the Sidewalk Account to the Highway Expense Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Dutch Elm Account to the Highway Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from the Dutch Elm Account to the Highway Expense Account.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Insect and Pest Control Account to the Highway Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$75.00 from the Insect and Pest Control Account to the Highway Expense Account.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Tree Warden Account to the Highway Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$1,002.50 from the Tree Warden Account to the Highway Expense Account.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from Free Cash to the Library Grant Account to restore monies which were inadvertently closed out in 1987, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Library Trustees)

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$2,855.10 from Free Cash to the Library Grant Account to restore monies which were inadvertently closed out in 1987.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m. 66 people attended the meeting on May 11, 1990.
