

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
FEBRUARY 5, 1991 7:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Tantasqua Regional School Agreement to read:

"Article IV - Transportation: For fiscal years commencing on and after July 1, 1991, school transportation to and from the regional school district shall be furnished by the Regional District and the cost thereof shall constitute part of its operating costs. The Tantasqua Regional School committee will, if petitioned to do so, contract with any one or more or with a group of its participating towns for the furnishing of all or part of the transportation requirements of the District for pupils residing in such participating town", or take any action relative thereto.

(Sponsored by the Advisory Board)

The town voted unanimously to amend the Tantasqua Regional School Agreement to read:

Article IV - Transportation: For fiscal years commencing on and after July 1, 1991, school transportation to and from the regional school district shall be furnished by the Regional District and the cost thereof shall constitute part of its operating costs. The Tantasqua Regional School committee will, if petitioned to do so, contract with any one or more or with a group of its participating towns for the furnishing of all or part of the transportation requirements of the District for pupils residing in such participating town.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for an unpaid bill for fiscal 1990, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$52.31 from Treasurer's Banking Services to the Town Clerk Expenses Account to cover an unpaid fiscal 1990 bill.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$8,312.50 from Article #35 of the May 8, 1987 annual town meeting, which is the town's share of Phase II of the Quaboag and Quacumquasit Restoration Project, to the following accounts: \$1,000.00 to the Street Light Account and \$7,312.50 to the Town Hall Improvement Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen).

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$8,312.50 from Article #35 of the May 8, 1987 annual town meeting, which is the town's share of Phase II of the Quaboag and Quacumquasit Restoration Project, to the following accounts: \$1,000.00 to the Street Light Account and \$7,312.50 to the Town Hall Improvement Account.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be used for the Central Communications Dispatch Account to cover an expected deficit and necessary expenses, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

The town unanimously voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Cemetery Expenses Account to the Cemetery Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Cemetery Commissioners)

The town unanimously voted to transfer the sum of \$3000.00 from the Cemetery Expenses Account to the Cemetery Salary Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Assessors to appoint one of its own members to provide additional services for the Board of Assessors and to provide compensation therefore at a rate of \$10.00 per hour from the Board of Assessors Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Assessors)

The town voted by a majority vote to authorize the Board of Assessors to appoint one of its own members to provide additional services for the Board of Assessors and to provide compensation therefore at a rate of \$10.00 per hour from the Board of Assessors Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Elections and Registration Expenses Account to the Elections and Registration Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Town Clerk)

The town unanimously voted to transfer the sum of \$267.43 from the Elections and Registration Expenses Account to the Elections and Registration Salary Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Water Department Operating Salary Account to the Water Department Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners)

The town unanimously voted to transfer the sum of \$700.00 from the Water Department Operating Salary Account to the Water Department Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Emergency Squad Expenses Account to the Emergency Squad Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Emergency Squad)

The town unanimously voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Emergency Squad Expenses Account to the Emergency Squad Salary Account.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Group Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

The town unanimously voted to transfer the sum of \$14,850.00 from the Landfill Account to the Group Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to allow the Treasurer to use the balance in the Treasurer's Computer Account to pay for data entry services and other computer supplies, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

The town unanimously voted to allow the Treasurer to use the sum of \$1,229.32, which is the balance in the Treasurer's Computer Account to pay for data entry services and other computer supplies.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the fiscal 1991 budget to the fiscal 1992 budget, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Advisory Board)

The town voted by a majority vote to transfer the following sums of money totalling \$42,299.50 from the fiscal 1991 budget to the fiscal 1992 budget:
