

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
SEPTEMBER 21, 1992 7:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the monies appropriated in Article #29 of the June 26, 1992 annual town meeting to a new account to be named the Selectmen's Demolition Account to be administered by the Board of Selectmen, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$2,000.00 which is the money appropriated in Article #29 of the June 26, 1992 annual town meeting to a new account to be named the Selectmen's Demolition Account to be administered by the Board of Selectmen.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to amend Article #23 of the June 26, 1992 annual town meeting warrant by deleting the words "in the aquifer at the Quaboag Street pumping station", or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners)

The Town voted unanimously to amend Article #23 of the June 26, 1992 annual town meeting warrant by deleting the words "in the aquifer at the Quaboag Street pumping station" so that the article reads: "to complete the first step in the long-term plan to control iron and manganese in accordance with the provisions of Mass. General Laws Chapter 41, section 69B."

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to drill and monitor the necessary test wells to deal with leachate from the landfill, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

The Town voted unanimously to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the purposes of closing and capping the town's landfill on Quaboag Street, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

The Town voted unanimously to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Assessors to use a sum of money from available funds in the Treasury for the reduction of the Tax Levy for the period from July 1, 1992 to June 30, 1993, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Assessors)

The Town voted unanimously to authorize the Assessors to transfer the sum of \$68,100.68 from the Stabilization Fund for the reduction of the Tax Levy for the period from July 1, 1992 to June 30, 1993.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to amend Article 18, the omnibus budget, of the June 26, 1992 annual town meeting, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Advisory Board)

The Town voted unanimously to amend Article 18, the omnibus budget, of the June 26, 1992 annual town meeting by changing the following line items:

- Line item #10a from \$2,975.00 to \$3,475.00
- Line item #10b from \$800.00 to \$900.00
- Line item #53 from \$31,412.00 to \$26,395.00 and
- Line item #57b from \$1,304,599.00 to \$1,274,599.00

The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m. 31 people attended the meeting.
