

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
FEBRUARY 22, 1993 7:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money for automated payroll services from April 1, 1993 to June 30, 1993 from the Interest-Temporary Loans Account to the Treasurer's Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted by a majority to transfer the sum of \$600.00 for automated payroll services from April 1, 1993 to June 30, 1993 from the Interest-Temporary Loans Account to the Treasurer's Expense Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Recycling Revolving Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$3,559.32 from Revenue Sharing Funds to the Recycling Revolving Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to enter into an agreement with the towns of Brimfield, Holland, Sturbridge and Wales and the Tantasqua Regional School District to operate a collaborative for the purpose of providing transportation for persons residing in said towns and school district; transportation shall include services to special education, vocational and regular day programs, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted unanimously to recommend that the Brookfield Elementary School Committee enter into an agreement with the towns of Brimfield, Holland, Sturbridge and Wales and the Tantasqua Regional School District to operate a collaborative for the purpose of providing transportation for persons residing in said towns and school district; transportation shall include services to special education, vocational and regular day programs.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be used to reconstruct and reconcile the records of the Town Accountant and Collector/Treasurer, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted by a majority to transfer the sum of \$7,500.00 to be used to reconstruct and reconcile the records of the Town Accountant and Collector/Treasurer.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Highway Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted by a majority to transfer the sum of \$19,127.75 from the Stabilization Fund to the Highway Expense Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Town Accountant's Clerk Salary Account to the Town Accountant's Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$1,648.00 the Town Accountant's Clerk Salary Account to the Town Accountant's Fee Account.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to drill, install and monitor the necessary test wells to deal with leachate from the landfill, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$25,000.00 from the Stabilization Fund to drill, install and monitor the necessary test wells to deal with leachate from the landfill.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to be used to immunize emergency personnel with Hepatitis-B vaccine, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$3,900.00 from the Stabilization Fund to be used to immunize emergency personnel with Hepatitis-B vaccine.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds to establish a Water Department Surplus Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted unanimously to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from Free Cash to the Stabilization Account, or take any action relative thereto.

The town voted unanimously to pass over this article.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:04 p.m. 37 people attended the meeting.
