

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
JUNE 25, 1993 7:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to set up a revolving fund for recycling for FY 94 in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 175 of the Acts of 1990 to receive monies for the maintenance and staffing of the recycling area provided that no monies shall be expended in excess of \$10,000.00, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Recycling Committee)

The town voted unanimously to set up a revolving fund for recycling for FY 94 in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 175 of the Acts of 1990 to receive monies for the maintenance and staffing of the recycling area provided that no monies shall be expended in excess of \$10,000.00.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to amend Section 2 of the town's Personnel By-Law by adding a new position entitled "Landfill and Recycling Monitor", or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Personnel Board)

The town voted unanimously to amend Section 2 of the town's Personnel By-Law by adding a new position entitled "Landfill and Recycling Monitor".

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from Free Cash to the Stabilization Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Advisory Board)

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$140,000.00 from Free Cash to the Stabilization Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Central Dispatch Account to cover an expected deficit for FY 93, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by Central Dispatch Advisory Board representative)

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$875.38 from the General Insurance Account to the Central Dispatch Account to cover an expected deficit for FY 93.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for Tax Title foreclosure expenses for FY 93, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$429.40 from the General Insurance Account for Tax Title foreclosure expenses for FY 93.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to amend Section 1.3 of Chapter XII of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield by deleting the words "five dollars (\$5.00)" and inserting in their place the words "twenty dollars (\$20.00)", or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Dog Officer)

The town voted unanimously to amend Section 1.3 of Chapter XII of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield by deleting the words "five dollars (\$5.00)" and inserting in their place the words "twenty dollars (\$20.00)", making the sentence read: "In any event, the Dog Officer shall not charge more than three dollars for a reimbursement of said expenses for each twenty-four hour period or any part thereof that the dog is held by him plus twenty dollars as a fee for the initial handling of such dog".

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Mass. Department of State Police to set up a regional PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point) to answer E-911 calls, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

The town voted by a majority to amend Article 7 to read: to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Mass. Department of State Police to set up a regional PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point) to answer E-911 calls but not to enter into any such contract until such contract is approved by town meeting vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m. 30 people attended the meeting.
