

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
OCTOBER 12, 1993 7:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to amend Line item 58b and Line item 58c of Article 17 of the adjourned annual town meeting of June 25, 1993 relating to the Regional School assessment and Regional School transportation, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

The town voted to amend Line item 58b and Line item 58c of Article 17 of the adjourned annual town meeting of June 25, 1993 relating to the Regional School assessment to \$711,411.00 and Line item 58c of Article 17 of the adjourned annual town meeting of June 25, 1993 relating to Regional School transportation to \$16,574.00

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Brookfield Elementary School budget, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Brookfield School Committee)

The town voted to raise and appropriate an additional \$105,749.00 for the Brookfield Elementary School budget.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the reconstruction and reconciliation of the Town Accountant's and Tax Collector's records, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Town Accountant)

The town voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000.00 for the reconstruction and reconciliation of the Town Accountant's and Tax Collector's records.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to pay bills from fiscal year 1993 for which no funds were available, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Town Accountant)

The town voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,220.99 to pay bills from fiscal year 1993 for which no funds were available.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to establish a Surplus Equipment Account and to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for this account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent)

The town voted to establish a Surplus Equipment Account and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,000.00 for this account with all purchases subject to authorization by the Board of Selectmen.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds to the Highway Tractor Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Superintendent)

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$2,276.00 from the sale of the 1968 Ford tractor to the Highway Tractor Account.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Dog Pound Account to an account to be called the Dog Kennel Construction Fund, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Dog Officer)

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$3,000.00 from the Dog Pound Account to an account to be called the Dog Kennel Construction Fund.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for a new portable radio and intercom system for the police station, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Chief)

The town voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,100.00 for a new portable radio and intercom system for the police station.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for a computer for the police department, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Chief)

The town defeated this article.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to provide for a salary increase for the Water Superintendent, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners)

The town voted to amend Article 17, line item 37c of the June 25, 1993 annual town meeting to read \$29,867.00 by raising and appropriating an additional sum of \$877.00.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to provide for a salary increase for the Water Department Clerk, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners)

The town voted to amend Article 17, line item 37a of the June 25, 1993 annual town meeting to read \$3,806.00 by raising and appropriating an additional sum of \$131.00.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to grant raises to all part-time employees included in the town's Personnel By-law, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

The town voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,062.00 to be added to the following line items of the FY 94 budget as voted at the annual town meeting:

ARTICLE 13. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds in the treasury to the Stabilization Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Advisory Board)

The town voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 14. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds in the treasury to reduce the fiscal 1994 tax levy, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

The town voted to transfer the sum of \$30,000.00 from the Stablization Fund to reduce the fiscal 1994 tax levy.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m. 42 people attended the meeting.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to amend the town's Personnel By-Law by eliminating the first four paragraphs of Section 26 and replacing them with the following: "The Board of Selectmen shall serve as the Personnel Board.", or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

The town voted by a majority to amend the town's Personnel By-Law by eliminating the first four paragraphs of Section 26 and replacing them with the following: "The Board of Selectmen shall serve as the Personnel Board."

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for tax title and tax title foreclosure expenses, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer/Collector)

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Group Insurance Account to the Tax Title Account for tax title and tax title foreclosure expenses.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the purpose of performing two more rounds of monitoring wells and to complete C.S.A. work, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$30,000.00 from the Stabilization Fund for the purpose of performing two more rounds of monitoring wells and to complete C.S.A. work.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to open a Landfill Closure Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

The town voted by a majority to open a Landfill Closure Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds for the Landfill Closure Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

The town voted by a majority to transfer the sum of \$5,000.00 from the Stabilization Fund to the Landfill Closure Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to amend Section 25 of the town's Personnel By-Law by removing references to the Board of Selectmen so that the Personnel Board shall be the final stage of the grievance procedure, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

The town voted by a majority to amend Section 25 of the town's Personnel By-Law so that it will now read:

"If any employee feels that he/she has not been fairly treated in accordance with this Personnel By-Law, that employee may enter a grievance in writing to his/her immediate supervisor, with copies being provided to the department head and Personnel Board/Board of Selectmen.

If the supervisor has not given the employee an acceptable reply within three (3) working days from the receipt of the grievance, the employee may enter a written appeal directly to the Personnel Board/Board of Selectmen with copies being provided to the supervisor and the department head.

The Personnel Board/Board of Selectmen must hold a hearing with the employee and provide a written response to the employee within fifteen (15) days from the receipt of the appeal. The response of the Personnel Board/Board of Selectmen shall be final."

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Recycling Revolving Account to purchase a flatbed trailer, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

After much discussion, the town voted to defeat this article.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 p.m. 49 people attended the meeting.
