~~The town voted by a majority to transfer the sum of \$2500.00 from the Interest/Temporary Loan Account to the Central Dispatch Account.~~

~~ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Veterans Casework Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Veterans Agent).~~

~~The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$6,223.00 from the Group Insurance Account to the Veterans Casework Account.~~

~~ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds to the Highway Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Department).~~

~~The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$9,000.00 from the General Insurance Account and \$5,000.00 from the Stabilization Account to the Highway Expense Account.~~

~~ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Emergency Squad Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Emergency Squad).~~

~~The town voted by a majority to transfer the sum of \$2,500.00 from the Group Insurance Account to the Emergency Squad Salary Account.~~
