

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

ARTICLE 1. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Library Expenses Account to the Library Salaries Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Library Trustees)

The Advisory Board recommends this article.

The town voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Interest on Temporary Loans Account to the Maturing Debt-Interest Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer).

The Advisory Board recommends this article.

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$2,787.44 from the Interest on Temporary Loans Account to Maturing Debt-Interest Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Medicare-Town's Share Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer)

The Advisory Board recommends this article.

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$1,550.00 from the General Insurance Account to the Medicare-Town's Share Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Emergency Squad Expense Account to the Emergency Squad Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Emergency Squad).

The Advisory Board recommends this article.

The town voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Emergency Squad Salary Account to the Emergency Squad Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Emergency Squad).

The Advisory Board recommends this article.

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$450.00 from Emergency Squad Salary Account to Emergency Squad Expense Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the town will vote to amend Chapter XII, section 1.6(a) of the town's by-laws by replacing the present section with the following:

"A late fee of ten dollars (\$10) per dog owner and fifteen dollars (\$15) per kennel owner per month, up to a maximum of twenty dollars (\$20) per dog owner and twenty-five dollars (\$25) per kennel owner shall be charged to each dog owner or kennel owner who fails to license said dog or dogs on or before July 1st of any year. These late fees will be paid before obtaining any license for said dog or dogs", or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Town Clerk and the Dog Officer).



ARTICLE 7. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Health to establish a revolving fund in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 44, section 53E1/2 to receive monies derived from permits issued by the Board of Health for construction and demolition debris at the landfill and to expend these monies to pay all costs associated with covering construction and demolition debris at the landfill provided that no monies shall be expended in excess of \$15,000.00, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health).

The Advisory Board recommends this article.

The Town voted unanimously to authorize the Board of Health to establish a revolving fund in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 44, section 53E1/2, effective through fiscal year 96, to receive monies derived from permits issued by the Board of Health for the construction and demolition debris at the landfill and to expend these monies to pay all costs associated with covering construction and demolition debris at the landfill provided that no monies shall be expended in excess of \$15,000.00.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Landfill Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

The Advisory Board recommends this article.

The Town voted to pass over this article.
