

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
APRIL 2, 1996 7:30 P.M.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Highway Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$20,000 from Free Cash to the Highway Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Landfill Cover Material Account to the Highway Dept. Used Truck Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Highway Supt.).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$3,432.00 from the Landfill Cover Material Account to the Highway Dept. Used Truck Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Water Department Clerk Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Water Commissioners).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$350.00 from the Water Department Expense Account to the Water Department Clerk Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Assistant Dog Officer's Salary Account to the Dog Officer Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Dog Officer).

The town voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Police Salaries Account to the Police Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Department).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$2,500.00 from the Police Salaries Account to the Police Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to purchase a new police cruiser, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Department).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$23,000.00 from Free Cash to purchase a new Ford police cruiser and to dispose of the 1991 cruiser at the Selectmen's discretion.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Elections & Registration Expenses Account to the Elections & Registration Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Town Clerk).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$250.00 from the Elections & Registration Expenses Account to the Elections & Registration Salary Account.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to pay for a prior year's bill, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Town Accountant). **9/10 vote required.**

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$501.50 from Free Cash to pay for Fall 1994 billing for the following departments: Cemetery - \$80.00, Dog Officer - \$60.00, Elementary School - \$87.00, Fire Department - \$38.50, Highway Department - \$38.50, Emergency Squad - \$50.00, and Recreation Commission - \$147.50.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Interest-Temporary Loans Account to the Medicare-Town's Share Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Treasurer).

The town voted unanimously to transfer the sum of \$3,500.00 from the Interest-Temporary Loans Account to the Medicare-Town's Share Account.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m. Thirty-five (35) people attended the meeting.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town Hall and Post Office in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.

HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as aforesaid.
