Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the police Dept. Expense Account or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Dept.)

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$6000.00 from Lottery Account and \$2000.00 from Stabilization Account to supplement the Police Dept. Expense Account.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Police Dept. Overtime Account or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Dept.)

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$2000.00 from the Stabilization Account to supplement the Police Dept. Overtime Account.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to establish an account, titled, the Mass Turnpike Tourism Grant Account to promote Town beautification and erect welcome signs and be expended by the Board of Selectmen or take any action relative thereto, (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen)

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$5000.00 from the Stabilization Account to a new account to be called, Mass Turnpike Tourism Grant Account.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:05 P.M. There were fifty-six (56) residents in attendance.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies thereof, to Town Hall and Post Office in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.
