To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of Worcester: GREETING:

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall, Banquet Hall in said town on Thursday, the Fifteenth day of March next at 7:00p.m. O'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Municipal Fuel Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Selectmen.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$3500.00 from the Town Counsel/Legal Fees Account to the Municipal Fuel Account to supplement an unforeseen rise in fuel cost.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Professional Services Accounting Salary Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Selectmen

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$8500.00 from the Town Counsel/Legal Fees Account to supplement the Professional Services Accounting Salary Account.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to the Water Main Replacement Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Water Dept.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$45,000.00 from the Stabilization Account to the Water Main Replacement Willow Brook Account.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Snow and Ice Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Highway Dept.

The town voted unanimously to transfer \$8,000.00 from the Stabilization Account to the Snow and Ice Account to supplement the unforeseen increase in snow and ice storms.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Election and Registration Expense Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Town Clerk.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$860.00 from the Stabilization Account to supplement the Election and Registration Expense Account.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Police Expense Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Police Dept.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$2,374.00 from the Stabilization Account to supplement the Police Dept. Expense Account.

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to the FY 2000 Unpaid Bills Account to pay Gulf Oil or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Police Dept.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$569.87 from the Stabilization Account to FY 2000 Unpaid Bills Account to pay Gulf Oil.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to the New Cruiser Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Police Dept.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$31,500.00 from the Stabilization Account to fund the new Police Cruiser Account.

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Veterans' Casework Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Veterans' Agent

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$6,000.00 from the Stabilization Account to supplement the Veterans' Casework Account.

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Veterans' Agent Expense Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Veterans' Agent

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$400.00 from the Stabilization Account to supplement the Veterans' Agent Expense Account.

Article 11. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to the FY 2000 Unpaid Bills Account to pay GBG Propane Services or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by Emergency Management Agency

The article was voted and amended to read as follows:

To see if the vote will to transfer the sum of \$20.45 to the FY2000 Unpaid Bills Account from the current Civil Defense Account to repay Peter Martell for this bill (GBG Propane Services)

The Town voted to transfer \$20.45 from the current Civil Defense Account to the FY2000 Unpaid Bill Account to repay Peter Martell for a bill (GBG Propane Services).

Article 12. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to the FY 2000 Unpaid Bills Account to pay Community Fire & Police Equipment or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by Emergency Management Agency.

The article was voted and amended to read as follows:

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$150.00 to the FY 2000 Unpaid Bill Account from the current Civil Defense Account to pay Community Fire & Police Equipment.

The town voted unanimously to transfer \$150.00 from the current Civil Defense Account to the FY2000 Unpaid Bill Account to pay Community Fire & Police Equipment.

Article 13. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money to the Selectmen's Expense Account or take any action relative thereto. Sponsored by the Advisory Board

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$750.00 from the Advisory Committee's Salary Account and \$20.00 from the Advisory Committee Expense Account to cover the costs to bulk mail the May Town Meeting Warrant Book to all residents of Brookfield.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof, at the Town Hall and Post Office in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of the holding of said meeting.

HEREOF, FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of the meeting, as aforesaid. Given under our hands this first day of March the year of our Lord, two thousand and one.
