

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MAY 10, 2002
BROOKFIELD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of Worcester:

GREETING:

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Brookfield Elementary School in said town on Friday, the Tenth day of May, 2002 next at 7:00p.m. O'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow or transfer a sum of money to the Town/s Unemployment Account to supplement the account. Sponsored by the Treasurer.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$4,530.00 from the Reserve Fund to the Town's Unemployment Account to supplement the account.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow or transfer a sum of money to the Health Insurance Account to supplement the account or take any. Sponsored by the Treasurer.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$28,200.00 from the Stabilization Account to the Health Insurance to supplement the account.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Assistant Town Clerk's Account to the Election and Registration Account Salary Account. Sponsored by the Town Clerk.

The Town voted to unanimously to transfer \$353.94 from the Assistant Town Clerks' Salary Account to Election and Registration Salary Account.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer or borrow a sum of money from the Police Salary Account to the Police Expense Account. Sponsored by the Brookfield Police Department. The voted to pass over this article.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money to the Emergency Squad Salary account. Sponsored by the Emergency Squad.

The town voted unanimously to transfer \$500.00 from Emergency Squad Expenses to Emergency Squad Salary.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Clerk's salary (01-510-5110-001) to the Transfer Station Expenses (01-515-5700-000). Sponsored by the Board of Health.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$347.00 Board of Health Clerks' Salary Account to the Transfer Station Expense Account.

Article 7. To see if the Town will transfer a sum of money from Animal Inspector (01-515-5700-000) to the Transfer Station Expense (01-515-5700-000). Sponsored by the Board of Health. The town voted unanimously to transfer \$926.00 from the Animal Inspector Account to the Transfer Station Account.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from "School aid Chapter 70" to Stabilization. Sponsored by the Advisory Committee.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$19,000.00 from School Aid Chapter 70 to the Stabilization Account.

Article 9. To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Selectmen Salary Account to Stabilization. Sponsored by the Advisory Committee.

The town voted unanimously to transfer \$676.00 from the Selectmen's Salary Account to the Stabilization Account.

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Brookfield Elementary School budget to the stabilization funds. Sponsored by the School Committee.

The Town voted to transfer \$50,000.00 from Brookfield Elementary School Budget to the Stabilization Account.

AND YOU ARE DIRECTED TO SERVE THIS WARRANT, BY POSTING UP ATTESTED COPIES THEREOF, AT THE TOWN HALL AND POST OFFICE IN SAID TOWN, FOURTEEN DAYS AT LEAST BEFORE THE TIME OF THE HOLDING OF SAID MEETING.

HEREOF, FAIL NOT, AND MAKE DUE RETURN OF THIS WARRANT, WITH YOUR DOINGS THEREON, TO THE TOWN CLERK, AT THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE MEETING, AS AFORESAID. GIVEN UNDER OUR HANDS THIS
