To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of Worcester: GREETING:

**IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Brookfield Elementary School in said town on Tuesday, the Twenty-fifth day of June next at 8:00p.m. o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following:**

**ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds to supplement the FY2002 Selectmen's Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.**

**The town voted unanimously to transfer \$492.00 from the Reserve Fund Account to the FY 2002 Selectmen's Expense.**

**ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds to supplement the FY2002 Administrative Assistant's Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.**

**The town voted unanimously to transfer \$1000.00 from the Town Hall Expense Account to the FY2002 Administrative Assistant's Salary Account.**

**ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds to supplement the FY2002 Police Department's Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.**

**The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$2707.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account to the FY2002 police Department's Expense to supplement the account.**

**ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds to supplement the FY2002 Police Department's Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.**

**The town voted unanimously to transfer \$1200.00 from the Street Light Account and \$1300.00 from Town Hall Expenses to the FY2002 Police Department's Salary Account.**

**ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer a sum of money to supplement the FY2003 salaries of those officials whose salaries would be affected by the removal of their fees collected from permits and or licenses, said amounts to be determined and approved by a town meeting vote in FY2003, or take any action relative thereto.**

**The Town voted to recommend the Board of Selectmen to insert an article on a FY2003 Special Town Meeting an amount to supplement the FY2003 salaries of the Town Clerk, Tax Collector and the Treasurer in an amount to be determined. 35 Yes 25 No**

**ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to rescind the action taken at the May 10, 2002 Annual Town Meeting, Article 8 which transferred \$19,000.00 from FY2002 Chapter 70 funds to the Stabilization Account, or take any action relative thereto.**

**The Town voted unanimously to rescind the action taken at the May 10, 2002 Annual Town Meeting, Article 8, which transferred \$19,000.00 from FY2002 Chapter to funds to the Stabilization Account.**

**ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$19,000 from the FY2002 School Appropriations Budget Account to the Stabilization Account, or take any action relative thereto.**

**The town voted to pass over this article.**

**ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to accept the Early Retirement Incentive, Chapter 116 of the Acts of 2002 or take any action relative thereto.**

**The Town voted by a majority to accept the Early Retirement Incentive, Chapter 116 of the Acts of 2002.**

**ARTICLE 9.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the FY2002 Emergency Squad Billing Receipt Account to supplement the FY2002 Emergency Squad Salary Account or take any action relative thereto.

The Town voted unanimously to transfer \$350.00 from the Emergency Squad Billing Receipt Account to FY2002 Emergency Squad Salary Account to supplement the account.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof, at the Town Hall and Post Office in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of the holding of said meeting.

*HEREOF, FAIL NOT,* and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of the meeting, as aforesaid. Given under our hands this tenth day of June in the year of our Lord, two thousand and two.
